

### Description

With the installation of this app, your Jira users will be able to manage until 4 custom description templates in your Jira instance. Very useful for repetitive tasks creation.

The user description templates are stored and processed in browser cookies. Just install and ready to use it. Plug & Play.

Since 2023 the Jira users can configure Description Templates by Project and IssueTypes with no Jira Admin intervention!!

And soon they will be able to configure Comment Templates!


#### Install addon

Follow the classic way to install using the *Find new apps* in your Jira instance (by your Jira Admin)


## General Configuration

The Jira Admin can go to "Manage Apps" "Global configuration: Description Templates"




And enable/disable the plugin features (Templates by project & Issuetype, and toolbars in description and comment fields in Issues)

Create a new issue with the usual standard button of Jira "Create" (or from board backlogs with description mandatory).




a specific text is added and we can use it. In this sample, We have stored different templates.




#### Usage: Description Templates by Project and IssueType




